COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP
CRITERIA FOR ART SCHOLARSHIP

In order to support and encourage education in visual arts, the Wickenburg Art Club offers a scholarship in the amount of \$1000 to a graduating senior or currently enrolled college student. The applicant should be committed to continuing their education in Art or a visual art-related field, such as, Design, Art History, etc. The Wickenburg Art Club will administer the fund. Winner has 2 years in which to use the award. Funds will be sent directly to the academic institution upon confirmation of registration. This scholarship is not directly renewable, however, WAC Scholarship recipients may re-apply yearly and be reviewed with the new graduating seniors.

Qualifications for Applicants

- Graduating Senior or currently enrolled college student from the Wickenburg area
- Graduating Senior or currently enrolled college student that is a child or grandchild of a Wickenburg Art Club member in good standing
- Academic standing of average or above
- Intent to major or currently majoring in Art or an visual art-related field
- Application submitted by April 1st
- Demonstrated accomplishment in Art via a portfolio review by a committee determined by the Wickenburg Art Club

Requirements for Submission

- Submit Application for Art Scholarship (including essay)
- Submit transcript from High School
- Submit one letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator
- Submit 5 - 7 pieces of original art.
 - Must be the student's original work. No copies. No kits or patterns used.
 - Two-dimensional pieces must be matted with 2" white mat. A 1/4' undermatting is optional. Matted pieces should be no larger than 18' x 24". Work may be framed, but this is optional.
 - Three-dimensional pieces should be no larger than 2'x2'x4' and ready to display on a pedestal.
 - Consult with the Scholarship Chairperson if the artwork that best represents your work does not fit into these criteria.
 - For each piece, include a Title, Artist, and Medium card filled in. (These will be provided by the Scholarship Chairperson.)
 - Submit the portfolio by April 10th. You will work with the Scholarship Chairperson to arrange a time to bring your work into the Wickenburg Art Center for the Scholarship Committee to review.
